

WHEN TRUTH COMES...

For twenty some years I was an avid bible reader. I believed as I was always taught that the bible had every answer to every question I could ever possibly come up with. In 1971, I joined a move of the Lord that was meeting in Los Angeles.

It was in this move that I really come into a new appreciation of the bible. We lived in the Word day and night. It was in this move that the leader pointed out that knowing the word would not solve your problems, but knowing the Lord would. It was in this move that I dropped my superstition concerning the bible for it was there that I learned that my answers would come from within if I would believe it.

For six of the years that I was in the move the Spirit of the Lord was in control of the members. In other words the Spirit was the head of the Body, not in doctrine but in reality. Then control came in and as it always does and when control moves in the spirit moves out. I stayed for two years praying that the Lord would come in and recover the spontaneity.

When the day arrived that I was convinced this was not going to happen I took a hike and never looked back. I will always cherish those eight years for what I gained through the unity was my insight into many things. I learned by experience that all the answers to the questions come from within. All of what I post here is from what I have seen. I can only relate the truth to you as I see it.

We all are coming out of the deception that we bought into while being influenced by mass consciousness. I'll speak for myself here and that way what I say will tend to be less offensive to some who may still be entrenched in the system of Christianity. The Lord once said that offenses must come, and come they will. There is a saying that goes, "If the truth hurts, it aught to."

My intention is to speak my heart and let the chips fall where they may, yet at the same time use wisdom in my deliverance. So with all this said, I'll begin. The church has been perpetuating sin consciousness for ever it seems. Personally I have a problem with that. Before I say more, I want to say that there are many streams of consciousness. The stream I address here is Christian.

All streams are from that which created me. No stream is in competition with any other stream. All streams are from God, and are God. Another way of saying this is that there are many levels of Consciousness, and all levels are different perspectives of the same truth. The Christian stream is only one level or one stream of consciousness. There are as many streams as there are perceivers.

So again tonight I'm speaking on the stream we know as Christian. I want to talk about sin consciousness and judgment. We Christians talk of forgiveness and that God will always forgive Sin. What about Paul's writings? Those tell me I am

crucified with Christ? What about Ephesians where he says that we are {present tense} seated together with Christ in heavenly places?

We Christians say we believe the word, but do we really? Could it just possibly be a matter of “Rightly dividing the word of truth?” I submit that this is a major problem, but it’s not the only problem. And here’s where it gets offensive to some. Is every word of the scriptures really infallible? My answer to this is absolutely not!

I could waste a lot of time here in sighting many scriptures that is not consistent with what our inner man knows Gods nature to be but here’s what I will say. My rule of thumb, {for lack of a better way to put it is this,} anything I read in scripture that is to me, contrary to what I know God to be, I reject.

Now what I accept as the word is dependent on where I am in my journey on the path. And, wherever I happen to be is certainly acceptable with the Lord. If for example I’m still under law, then the God of the O. T. is acceptable to me. If you accept Jehovah’s dealings with the gentile tribes we read of on the Old Testament who am I to adjust your belief system?

What I share is with the attitude, if this works for you then great. If it doesn’t then you’re free of course to either reject it altogether or put it on the shelf for future reference. Either way I’m ok with how you respond. Let’s talk about the crucifixion of the Christ.

I was converted to Christ in 1969. That experience left me with and insatiable hunger for answers that would bring me into the fullness of the experience of the resurrection. I had read where Paul said, “That I might know him, and the power of his resurrection.” That verse spoke to me. I knew it was possible to know this resurrection experience.

Suffice it to say I jumped in with both feet and studied the scriptures day and night in prayer, for I wanted to find the reality I had lost due to what I thought was my sin nature. Slowly over many years I begin to see the oneness of creation. The truth that had always been the treasure hidden in the field began to be revealed to me.

I had been told for years that I had been crucified with Christ. I had read this in the scriptures and also in many books in my quest to know whatever would bring me the peace I had lost. Eventually the reality of my oneness with God and all of creation began to dawn upon my consciousness. I realized that what Jesus said was also true of me.

“He that has seen me has seen the Father.” I see today that just as Paul wrote, there is only one Spirit. This I know to be true. This one Spirit is God. ALSO, THIS Spirit is the root, the very core of all of us. You have the same spirit as I have.

There is only one and this one is our true identity. Paul in acts when delivering his Gospel on Mars Hill said when speaking of Christ, *"In whom we live and move and have our Being."*

The spirit that dwells in me is the same one that dwells in you and all of creation. It's the life principle of all, from the smallest to the greatest. It resides in the beetle as well as you and I. now... there is but this one Spirit that created all things but there are many, many souls. Every soul that exists, is the one Spirit stepped down in vibration.

For all the years I was taught that I was crucified with Christ I could not wrap my mind around that truth until I saw oneness. I read books that said, when Christ died, you died and when Christ was resurrected you were resurrected, but I could not it reality identify with this truth. It was not until I realized that we are all one Spirit that I saw it.

Actually the real crucifixion took place not in the physical realm but in the spiritual realm. Jesus Christ was God appearing in flesh. Listen my friends, **SO ARE YOU!** You could not possibly be anything else since there is nothing in existence but God. If anything else exists, please tell me where could it have possibly come from?

All creation is an emanation of the one Spirit. This means that when Jesus died on the cross, I died with him. When he resurrected, guess who else did... we did! Either the revelation of oneness has claimed me or it hasn't. If it has, then I can totally identify with the death and resurrection of Christ two thousand years ago.

If I see oneness, then I totally understand that anything that happens to another of Gods creations happens to me. If just a good portion of humanity saw these things, would war cease to exist? Absolutely! When the Spirit reveals to me, the truth concerning oneness never again can I be divisive over doctrine or teaching. Never can I take issue with someone, anyone who would disagree with me.

When humanity knows the truth, it will put up the sword. I love H.T.H. because of the freedom to be who I am! I love all of you. I love my brother who gives so much it scares you. I am qualified to say this because I grew up with him. Gary has the heart of David. This passion he has for all of us comes from his miserable efforts to please a God who has always been quite pleased with his creation. We've all been guilty of the attempt to improve on Gods creation. According to the allegory this was Adams mistake. So if you take the stand of Christian, know this... all of your "sins" were paid for two thousand years ago when you my friend were crucified with Christ. That was the only judgment that you will ever undergo as far as God is concerned.

All other judgment brought on in this life is only due to my ignorance of who I really am or what the truth is concerning me. If I believe that I am a sinner I negate

the work of the cross. God has judged me once and will not do it again. I was judged in Christ, period, period! Paul wrote, "*There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus, who walk not after the flesh but after the spirit.*"

To walk after the spirit is only to know that not only am I seated with Christ in heavenly places but that the reality of that comes when I come to where I realize that I've never been lost. It is then that I have transferred out of the old creation and been born into the new. Also perfection is what I've been all along. This revelation for me came by way of the Christian gospel.
