

The Third coming of Jesus Christ

Today's Christian church like Christians of the past are waiting for the second coming of our Lord, They've listened to the preachers and teachers saying that soon, just around the corner, Jesus will come again to rapture the church up into the air and so they will ever be with the Lord. Popular books such as the Late Great Planet Earth by Hal Lindsay have taken the church by storm to believe something that has already occurred. Yes that is what I said, already occurred.

Jesus told his disciples that He would return during their time and He did so. He sent the Holy Spirit on the day of Pentecost to give them an earnest of what was to come so that they would know and heed and understand the signs of the times and the warnings that He gave them, so that when He came they would know and flee to the mountains. This they did when the Lord came back the second time at the destruction of the temple in 70 A.D. Should you be an individual that's waiting for the rapture you are waiting for something that will not happen. The rapture doctrine is a relatively new teaching that was not taught by the early church or the church fathers or for the first few centuries of the church. The rapture theory was brought in by a Jewish Jesuit Priest into the Catholic faiths. His name was Francisco Ribera. He was aided in the futurism doctrine by Robert Bellarmine. In my opinion Ribera was what is known as a Merano that is a Jew who feigns conversion to Christianity but inwardly he still retains and follows the Jewish teachings most of which is that of the Talmud. If the second coming has occurred which I believe to be true, and Jesus destroyed the Mosaic law with the destruction of Jerusalem and the temple in 70 A.D. why do I think there will be a third coming? Brother Amiraault in his teaching, asks the question is there a double

fulfillment to prophecy? I'm not saying there is a double fulfillment but the Mosaic Law that was supposed to have been destroyed at the destruction of the physical temple is still around today in all the churches. For all the churches teach the Mosaic law in some form or other. So what happened after Jesus destroyed the temple which was supposed to have destroyed the Mosaic Law for that was the purpose of his second coming... not a rapture. The Jewish and Gentile Christians of that time were scattered all around the Middle East in small groups, churches and fellowships. Some returned to Jerusalem to start up a fellowship there after the destruction of the temple; other's moved outward to spread the good news of the gospel of Jesus Christ. But they held onto the Mosaic Law as well. You see Paul brought the gospel of grace but he also held onto the Mosaic Law. He was a Pharisee of the Pharisees. And the Pharisees taught both the Mosaic Law and the oral law, the Babylonian Talmud, and Paul never lost that teaching. In fact, James commanded him to go out to the gentiles and to keep certain portions of the Mosaic Law and at one point commanded Paul to come back under the Law. So Paul was preaching a mixed message and you

can see that in his letters. Some letters talk about grace others speak about being under the Law, such as women must keep silent in the church, obey them that have the rule over you, etc etc.

The churches of today have believers in them and they are supposed to be the temple of God so if we are the temple what does God require of us to be. Is he requiring us to be a mixture of law and grace or are we a temple not built with hands, s new clean creation? If he came back the second time to destroy the Mosaic Law, as many believe, through the destruction of the temple in Jerusalem would he not complete his mission by destroying the temple within us if we maintain and hold onto the Mosaic Law? How this will be accomplished I don't know, but I believe he will do so in some way or other. We are temples not made with hands and that temple must be a temple of Love not of law. Judge you this day whom you will serve. Search your heart to make sure that you are following the great commandment, 'Love the Lord they God with all they heart.' Your temple is to be one of a broken and contrite heart.
